Set Appointment Time: We have a pathways program for people we serve through 360
Access Hub. Upon meeting eligibility criteria, you will receive a 5- to 7-day supply of
food, if needed, every 30 days while you are working with our team on a sustainability
plan over 6 months.

For your intake into our 360 Access Hub Pathways Program, someone will contact you by November 14th to get your paperwork completed so you can come back if needed within the 30-day window.

(NOTE - criteria we have multiple funding streams and ways to serve so we'll help put you on the best path based on your circumstances, and that will be talked about at your appointment.)
